Regional Translocality in Historical Perspective: the Case of Slavonia and Bosnia

This project aims to establish a partnership between Department for the History of Slavonia, Sirmia and Baranya of the Croatian Institute of History in Slavonski Brod (Hrvatski institut za povijest – Podružnica za povijest Slavonije Srijema i Baranje), and the Zentrum für Mittelmeerstudien at the Ruhr Universität Bochum, as well as the Lehrstuhl für Ost- und Südosteuropäische Geschichte in Leipzig at the Universität Leipzig. The partnership will be funded by the Alexander von Humboldt Foundation. It is organized around interdisciplinary research on historical interactions between Slavonia (comprising the eastern parts of the Republic of Croatia) and Bosnia (consisting of the northern and central parts of Bosnia and Herzegovina) – two neighbouring and historically heavily interconnected regions that are today delimited by the state and regional border along the river Sava – and their consequences. Also, this project will look into comparative cases in other parts of Southeast Europe and adjacent regions (such as the Pannonian Basin) and theoretical approaches to translocality in general.

Die “Enzyklopädie Jugoslawiens” (1955-1990) zwischen jugoslawischem und subjugoslawischem Nationbuilding

Die Enzyklopädie Jugoslawiens (EJ) war das Vorzeigeprojekt der sozialistisch staatlich geförderten jugoslawischen Lexikographie. Die erste Auflage der EJ wurde in einer serbokroatischen Version (1955-71) veröffentlicht, aber die unvollendete zweite Auflage der EJ (1980-90) erschien in slowenischer, serbokroatischer (lateinischer und kyrillischer Schrift), mazedonischer, ungarischer und albanischer Version. Die EJ wurde als Mittel konzipiert, um den jugoslawischen Völkern das Gefühl einer gemeinsamen Identität auf der Grundlage von Kultur und Geschichte zu vermitteln, erhielt jedoch gleichzeitig die manchmal widersprüchliche Aufgabe der Nationenbildung auf der Ebene der subjugoslawischen föderalen Einheiten sowie des Identitätsausbaus der Völkern und Nationalitäten. Wie hat der EJ-Inhalt die Nationenbildung auf jugoslawischer und subjugoslawischer Ebene dargestellt; war die EJ die Stimme bestimmter nationalbildender politischer Positionen oder Vorurteile; wie haben die nationenbildenden Konzepte in der EJ die Wissensproduktion darin geprägt und wie hat sich dies auf die Öffentlichkeit ausgewirkt? Das projekt ist an der Humboldt-Uni. gesiedelt und wird in Parterschaft mit dem Kroatischen

Institut für Geschichte durchgeführt. Die Konferenz des Projektes und die Forschung werden in Zusammenarbeit mit dem Lexicografisches Institut Miroslav Krleža organisiert.

Asserting Turkey in Bosnia and Herzegovina. Turkish Foreign Policy and Pro-Turkish Activism in Bosnia: Actors, Discourses and Textual Corpora (2002-2014)

The main goal of this book is to analyze Turkish foreign policy towards Bosnia and Herzegovina under the AKP as well as the networks of Turkish and local actors in Bosnia that support it. Dino Mujadžević looks into how the discourses and actors that emerged in this framework – both in Turkey and as part of Bosnian pro-Turkish activism – interact and respond to each other, and how they have been adapting to the local challenges. Also, Turkish foreign policy under the AKP and its allies in Bosnia is approached as being part of the phenomena related to mainstream Islamic conservatism in both countries. The period selected (2002–2014) represents a chronological section identified by the AKP rule, which most researchers see as an era of the dominance of so-called Neo-Ottomanism in Turkish official and non-official foreign policies towards the Balkans. *Asserting Turkey in Bosnia* assesses the influence of Turkish foreign policy on Bosnian Muslims, especially among Islamic conservatives, as well as regional reactions to these processes. The focus of this book is on the study of textual sources, including digitized ones. Interpretative analyses in the book rely on the theoretical framework of the Critical Discourse Analysis, which will be implemented through pure qualitative methods as well as the corpus method, a synergy between qualitative and empirical-quantitative approaches.

Bakarić. Politička biografija

Knjiga je prva politička biografija Vladimira Bakarića, čovjeka koji je više od 40 godina gotovo odlučujuće utjecao na politički život u Hrvatskoj. Temelji se na doktorskoj disertaciji, što ju je autor obranio na Filozofskom fakultetu u Zagrebu 2009. godine. Riječ je o iznimno zanimljivom, gotovo publicistički pisanom djelu, koje cjelovito prati Bakarićev život, djelovanje i značenje u hrvatskoj i jugoslavenskoj politici. Autor uspijeva proniknuti u dramatične pa i proturječne procese toga doba i smješta Bakarića u realni kontekst povijesnih odnosa i okolnosti. Posebno je zanimljiv Bakarićev pogled na hrvatsko nacionalno biće i hrvatsku državnost te njegov odnos s Titom. Autor kritički ukazuje na ograničenja u Bakarićevoj politici te analizira sustav, koji je unatoč svim reformama, u osnovi ostao autoritaran sve do demokratskih promjena 1990-ih.

Digital Historical Research on Southeast Europe and the Ottoman Space

As digital humanities in recent years have been taking roots in major international research centers, this edited volume consisting of ten papers including the introduction seeks to examine the current state of the digital/data-driven research in history and neighboring disciplines dealing with Southeast Europe as well as with the Ottoman Empire and to give an interdisciplinary impetus by bringing together international scholars working with various digital approaches. The included papers give a broad

introduction into the field and follow various methods of digital analysis and visualization incorporating approaches like corpus-assisted critical discourse analysis, GIS (Geographic Information Systems), agent-based modelling, computational statistics etc.

Annotated Legal Documents on Islam in Europe: Croatia (collection of documents)

This volume of *Annotated Legal Documents on Islam in Europe* covers Croatia and consists of an annotated collection of legal documents affecting the status of Islam and Muslims. The legal texts are published in the original Croatian language while the annotations and supporting material are in English. By legal documents are meant the texts of legislation, including relevant secondary legislation, as well as significant court decisions. Each legal text is preceded by an introduction describing the historical, political and legal circumstances of its adoption, plus a short paragraph summarising its content. The focus of the collection is on the religious dimensions of being Muslim in Europe, i.e. on individuals' access to practise their religious obligations and on the ability to organise and manifest their religious life.

Franjevci u Slavonskom Brodu. Zbornik radova sa znanstvenog skupa održanog 27. listopada 2007. u Slavonskom Brodu

Povodom znanstvenog skupa Podružnica i Franjevački samostan u zajedničkoj su nakladi tiskali i knjižicu naslovljenu Franjevci u Slavonskom Brodu. 500 godina djelovanja franjevac. 300 godina utemeljenja samostana. 280 godina gradnje crkve i samostana u nakladi od 250 primjeraka. Knjižica sadrži program (tj. popis sudionika i izlaganja) te sažetke svih izlaganja na hrvatskom. Na skupu su izlaganja održali eminentni slavonski i/ili franjevački povjesničari, kao i povjesničari umjetnosti, kroatisti, arhivisti i konzervatori. Izlaganja su pretežito bila posvećena „zlatnom dobu“ franjevačke prisutnosti u Slavonskom Brodu, 17. i 18. stoljeću, no dio njih je zadiralo u ranija i kasnija razdoblja. U prvom, prijepodnevnom dijelu skupa, posvećenom općim temama vezanim za problematiku slavonskobrodskih franjevaca i Slavonskog Broda općenito, nastupili su Milan Vrbanus, Zlata Živaković-Kerže, Emanuel Hoško, Mijat Jerković, Damir Matanović, Andrija Zirdum i Domagoj Šimunović. U popodnevnoj sesiji, posvećenoj pojedinim posebnim pitanjima iz slavonskobrodске franjevačke povijesti, izlagali su: Željka Perković, Egidije Biber, Marija Mirković, Luka Slijepčević, Mijo Hrman, Ivo Pranjković, Robert Skenderović, Ivan Medved, Hrvoje Špicar, Irena Krumes Šimunović i Silvana Ereiz. Nažalost, u ovom zborniku ne nalaze se sva izlaganja ili radovi nastali na temelju njih. Naime, uredništvo ni nakon opetovanih molbi nije dobilo neke od radova za objavljivanje, dok nekoliko radova nije uvršteno zbog neprilagođenosti strogo znanstvenoj koncepciji zbornika.
